GJA met on the above date at the Jacksonville Elementary School. Vice President Jack Armstrong called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm. In attendance were approximately 18 persons. Mr. Armstrong introduced the board members who were present.

The minutes of the June 18 meeting were approved as submitted. Treasurer Marc Peters reported that there was an account balance of \$13,999.40 as of August 31, 2013.

Mr. Armstrong introduced Lt. Bob McGraw who reported for BCPD Precinct 7 who reported on crime in the area. There have been some nighttime thefts from cars in the Sunnybrook area and burglaries on Dance Mill and Sweet Air. Suspects have been identified. School resource officers have been added to county middle schools as well as those already in place at high schools.

Representatives from the Mad Potter and Birds and Beyond, new stores in Jacksonville, described their businesses to the audience.

Mr. Armstrong noted that a slate of offices and directors was needed for the November meeting at which elections will be held. Membership renewals are due by January for the 2014 year.
