

Jacksonville Association, Inc.
General Membership Meeting Minutes
Tuesday, November 23, 2010

GJA met on the above date at Jacksonville Elementary School. President Glen Thomas called the meeting to order at 7:40 p.m. Approximately 25 persons were in attendance. Mr. Thomas reported that notice of the meeting had been sent out.

The minutes of the October 19, 2010 meeting were approved as submitted. Treasurer Doug Oakley reported that as of October 31 there was a balance of \$12,857.32 in the treasury.

Mr. Thomas reported for the Cockeysville Precinct of the BCPD that there had been a rash of garage and car thefts with valuables stolen in the area – Dance Mill, Blenheim, and Manor Brook Court – between 2 and 5 am with entrance gained through unlocked doors and windows.

Mr. Thomas reported on the recent MDE public meeting on Exxon's request to raise water withdrawal limits in the MTBE remediation process. More wells have been drilled or deepened in the NE quadrant of Four Corners after discovery of MTBE in the amount of 10,000 ppb at one of the monitoring sites at 300 feet deep. Handouts and maps of recovery and test wells were distributed.

Mr. Palmer reported that the Peter Angelos trial re the Exxon spill was scheduled to begin in January with jury selection soon underway.

Nominating Committee members Bob Butler and Mark Ellerkmann were introduced by Chairman Glen Thomas. They submitted a slate with one vacancy:

Directors: Susan Anthony, Jack Armstrong, Lisa Connolly-Bailey, Marc Peters, and Wil Sauerbrey

From the floor, Jack Armstrong nominated Bill Ensor for the vacant seat on the board. Nominations were closed and the slate accepted.

Mr. Thomas noted that dues would remain \$12 per calendar year and were due shortly for 2011.

Under new business, a request was made to investigate installing a street light at the Safeway entrance on Sweet Air Road. Mr. Ensor agreed to call SHA to ask for an update on the long-postponed improvement to the Four Corners intersection.

Upcoming meetings of GJA are scheduled for Tuesday, December 21 and Tuesday, January 18.

There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:10 pm.
